do solemnly and sincerely declare that in the above mentioned birth entry the name of the father is erroneously recorded as 'Andre Evrett Frederick WILLIAMS' instead of as 'Andre Evrett Frederick WILLIAMS otherwise Willoughby D'Eresby WALMISLEY'; that the father was one and the same person as Willoughby D'Eresby WALMISLEY whose birth on 25 November 1895 was registered at entry number 52 in the West Battersea sub-district of the Wandsworth Registration District on 8 January 1896 who at the time of the birth had assumed use of the name Andre Evrett Frederick WILLIAMS; that I knew the father of Paul Walmisley WILLIAMS as Andre Evrett Frederick WILLIAMS and was made aware of his former identity as Willoughby D'Eresby WALMISLEY when attending a court case in which he was involved, the details of which were recorded in The London Gazette dated 19 May 1950 and 4 June 1954; that the man I knew as Andre Evrett Frederick WILLIAMS was one and the same person as the person who attended court as Willoughby D'Eresby WALMISLEY....

AND I make this solemn Declaration, conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835. declared by the said
